

## Call for Proposals Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) and Artificial Intelligence (AI) Joint SIG Meeting. Salzburg, Austria.

The aim of this SIG meeting is to bring together colleagues interested in both AI and EDI: test providers, administrators, educators and researchers, to share knowledge and research in the field, promote best practice and discuss present and future developments with regard to AI and EDI.

Proposals for presentations are invited on the following topics:

- 1. Research, policies, processes and resources related to accessibility and the provision of special accommodations in Al-powered assessment systems;
- 2. Practices in test development, production and quality review, with a focus on integrating EDI considerations into Al-powered processes.

We especially encourage proposals that deal with the following themes:

- Potential bias in Al systems and Al training data
- Data governance and retention issues
- Transparency and explainability
- Ethics in algorithmic decision making
- Accessibility of AI systems in diverse socioeconomic and geographical contexts
- Discrimination and diversity in AI test content production
- Ethical auditing and broader moral issues around Al

Proposals for presentations on other topics related to EDI and AI are also welcomed. Following the presentations, there will be an opportunity for open discussion of new developments and emerging issues.
